### **Thank you for joining us this Lord's Day to worship at Covenant Presbyterian Church!**

To all our visitors: **Thank you for joining us this morning in the worship of the Lord our God.** Jesus said, "God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24). It is our prayer you will sense the presence of God's Spirit as you are with us today. Please take one of the Visitor Cards from the holder on the back of the pew, fill it out, place it in the offering plate or hand it to the pastor as you leave the sanctuary today. This will enable us to learn something about you and to send you a note of thanks for being with us. We promise to keep this information confidential and only use it for personal follow-up contact with you and your family.

We observe the **Lord's Supper** on the first Sunday of each month. We invite to the Lord's Table all who are disciples of Jesus Christ, set apart unto him by baptism and a profession of faith before the leaders of a local evangelical congregation of Christ's Church. By joining with us at the Table, you are acknowledging to the leadership of this local church you are in covenant with God as an active member in good standing of your home congregation. You acknowledge you are a sinner, without hope except in the sovereign mercy of God, and you are trusting in Jesus Christ alone for salvation.

**NOTE: We use wine in communion because we believe Jesus used wine with his disciples at the Last Supper.** However, grape juice is also made available in the trays. The wine is clearly red and dark in color; while the grape juice is white or pale yellow in color. Ask a server, if in doubt.

Our missionaries to pray for this week are those on the staff with the Mission to North America office in Atlanta. Pray for these men and women as they seek to provide the needed work for the following ministries: church planting, church renewal and the ministry of the chaplains.
